Lavonn Meier-McKnight Memorial Scholarship

To be considered for this scholarship, the recipient must meet and maintain the following criteria:

- 1. Applicant must be a continuing student
- 2. Applicant must be a student-athlete
- 3. Applicant must be an Education major
- 4. Applicant must complete the scholarship application form through the Financial Aid Office on any Northwestern campus
- 5. Applicant must have at least a 2.5 CGPA based on a 4.0 scale to receive the scholarship
- 6. Preference will be given to the applicant who exhibits the combination of the highest levels of hard work, discipline, character, and academic and athletic excellence

C.L. Dick Highfill Scholarship (\$400.00)

Awarded to an NWOSU student with at least a 2.5 CGPA. First preference will be given to applicants residing in Northwest Oklahoma. Second preference will be given to applicants residing in South Central Kansas. Preference will also be given to those applicants with a stated interest in teaching or coaching with the expression of a desire to make a difference with the young men and women whose lives they touch.

W.D. and Lucille B. Newby Scholarship (\$300.00)

Awarded to an NWOSU continuing student majoring in Health & Sports Science Education or in a wellness/nutrition field of study. The recipient must have a 3.0 CGPA. Oklahoma residents and those candidates who exhibit strong leadership skills will be given priority.

Lt. Mike Warehime Scholarship (\$150.00)

Awarded to an NWOSU student from nominations submitted by the Chairperson of the Health & Sports Science Education Department.
