# **Student Learning Outcomes**

As a result of study in the general education curriculum at Northwestern, students will achieve the following learning outcomes in literacy, critical thinking, and ethical leadership.

#### Literacy. Students will

- 1. solve problems using appropriate mathematical skills.
- 2. demonstrate effective written and oral communication skills.
- 3. display skill in effective personal financial planning and money management.
- 4. explain principles of mental and physical wellness.
- 5. solve problems or explain principles in nature through scientific relationships
- 6. explain the scope and value of human diversity.
- 7. articulate how the arts lead to enhancing the human experience.

## **Critical Thinking.** Students will

- 1. demonstrate effective inquiry, reasoning, and analysis related to important problems and issues.
- 2. gather, analyze, and communicate information effectively.
- 3. solve problems using well-informed decision-making processes.

## **Ethical Leadership.** Students will

- 1. demonstrate knowledge of civic responsibility and engagement.
- 2. apply principles of ethical reasoning and decision making.
- 3. collaborate with others in achievement of defined goals.
