This semester the Office of Assessment & Institutional Effectiveness (A & IE) administered a variety of recurring assessments and surveys, including the ETS Proficiency Profile, Staff Satisfaction Survey, Administrator Evaluations, Co-Curricular Learning Survey, Alumni Survey, Graduate Satisfaction Survey, and National Survey of Student Engagement (NSSE) Survey. Each of the tools mentioned is administered either annually or on a 2- to 3-year rotation.

Higher Learning Commission Accreditation

NWOSU's next comprehensive visit is January 22-23, 2024. HLC conducts comprehensive evaluations to confirm that the institution meets the Criteria for Accreditation and other HLC requirements, is pursuing institutional improvement, and complies with requirements set by the U.S. Department of Education. HLC peer reviewers will visit NWOSU for an on-site evaluation of NWOSU's efforts to meet HLC Criteria for Accreditation. Before they visit, they will review the Assurance Argument, Federal Compliance Filing, and a Student Opinion Survey.

Accreditation is the primary means of assuring and advancing the quality of education in institutions of higher education.
