*The same type of item can count multiple times. For example, publishing 2 different articles could count for 2 items for a year.

Interpretation in Special Cases: for initial tenure, promotion, or single year portfolios

- 1. Five-year portfolios:
- Items A and B can each count for three years (the date of publication/completion and 2 preceding years).
- To achieve a ranking of "1. Exceptional Performance" all 5 years need to meet the level required by satisfying conditions (I), (II), or (III). Failing that, to achieve a ranking of "2. Professional Level Performance" all 5 years need to meet at least the level required by satisfying conditions (IV) or (V).
- For example, if a book in the discipline was published in portfolio year 2 and a terminal degree completed in portfolio year 4, then the book counts in portfolio years (PY) 1 and 2, the degree in portfolio years 2, 3, and 4. So with no other artifacts, years PY1 through PY5 would individually rank as in the table:

Here we are using "Rank 2 (IV)" to indicate the conditions of rank "2. Professional Level" were met by satisfying condition IV in the rubric. In PY5, no artifacts were included, so the yearly rank score would be 4.

• Suppose in addition to the book in year 2 and degree in year 4, the portfolio contains artifacts of types 1 to 8 as indicated in the following table.

- As this Portfolio has not received a score of 1 for each year, but has receive a score of 2 or better, it should score a 2 for this item in the rubric. In other words, the portfolio meets at least the conditions of "2. Professional Level Performance," each year because condition (IV) was satisfied in each of years 1 through 4, and condition (V) was met in year 5.
- Suppose in addition to the book in year 2 and degree in year 4, the portfolio contains artifacts of types 1 to 8 as indicated in the following table.

- As this Portfolio has received a score of 1 for each year, it should score a 1 for this item in the rubric. This means that regarding "1. Exceptional Performance," condition (I) was met in year 2; for years 1, 3, and 4, one additional artifact of type 1-8 fulfilled condition (II); and for year 5, three artifacts of type 1-8 meet condition (III).
- 2. One-year portfolios: Ranking of "1. Exceptional Performance" requires one of items A or B during the past 3 years or meeting condition (III) for the year of the portfolio. To achieve "2. Professional Level Performance" (necessarily without item A or B) the faculty member must satisfy condition (V) for the year of the portfolio.
