Northwestern-Alva: www.nwosu.edu

Northwestern's main campus is located in Alva, a city with more than 5,000 residents in northwest Oklahoma. This campus offers students a traditional college experience with university housing, dining in the cafeteria or Student Center, participating in campus activities, and much more. At the Alva campus, students can choose from more than 40 areas of study to earn their Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science degrees. The location currently offers complete master's degree programs in education, counseling psychology, general psychology, American Studies, and Heritage Tourism & Conservation, as well as a hybrid doctoral degree for the BSN-to-DNP program.

At our Enid location, you will find a state-of-the-art facility that offers traditional classroom environments, as well as ITV classes and online classes. The Enid campus offers upper-division courses for bachelor's degree completion in 19 subject areas, the same complete master's degree programs as listed for the Alva campus, as well as a hybrid doctoral degree for the BSN-to-DNP program. Many students take advantage of the Bridge Program, a cooperative agreement between Northern Oklahoma College and Northwestern, to make a smooth transition to Northwestern for the completion of their four-year degree.

Students attending classes at our Woodward location can take the same types of undergraduate courses that are available at Northwestern's main campus in Alva. Professors are available on-site, as well as via ITV classes and online. At the Woodward campus, students can take all classes needed for general education requirements and coursework needed to complete undergraduate degrees in 19 subject areas. Woodward also offers the same complete master's degree programs as listed for the Alva campus, as well as a hybrid doctoral degree for the BSN-to-DNP program.

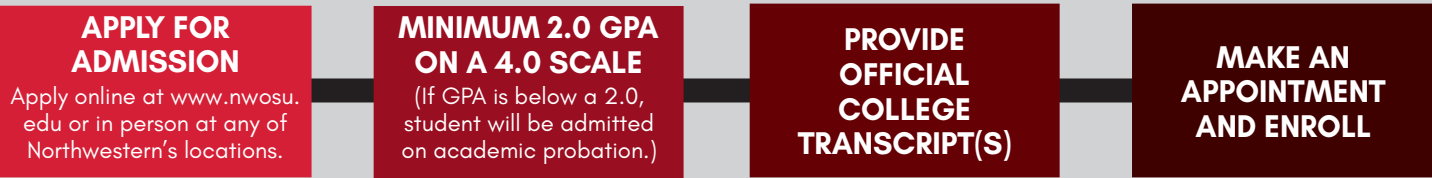
This one-time scholarship is available to students who enter the "Bridge Program" before graduating and earning an associate degree at NOC. The tuition scholarship amount will be based on cumulative grade point average as follows:

2.0-2.99	\$1,000 for the academic year
3.0-3.49	\$1,400 for the academic year
3.5-4.00	\$1,900 for the academic year

This scholarship is stackable with the associate degree and transfer academic scholarships seen at right.

How to Transfer



Transfers with fewer than 24 hours earned must also submit a final high school transcript and ACT/SAT scores (if taken) AND meet freshman admission requirements.

Scholarships

• **TRANSFER DEGREE SCHOLARSHIP: \$1,900 toward tuition, 1/2 cost of semi-private room**, one academic year. Associate degree & 3.5 to 4.0 CGPA – Must establish residency in Alva during academic year.*

• **TRANSFER DEGREE SCHOLARSHIP: \$1,400 toward tuition**, one academic year. Associate degree & 3.0 to 3.49 CGPA – Must establish residency in Alva during academic year.*

• **TRANSFER ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP: Up to \$1,500 toward tuition**, one academic year. Completion of 24 credit hours & a 3.5 CGPA.
